FILMING TARIFFS

1. All Filming Tariffs are approved by SANParks management every three years.
2. Filming Tariffs will be available from the service provider, permit official and the SANParks website.
3. Unless waived and funded by a relevant SANParks authority, all filming parties will be required to pay Accommodation and Conservation Fees, along with all other filming/photography tariffs.
 - 3.1.1 All film crews will be required to pay for accommodation and conservation fees at the standard tourist's rate.
 - 3.1.2 Accommodation & entry will only be waived in exceptional circumstances as stated in the Filming and Photography Policy and provisions of the Filming and Photography Permit Tarrifs.



