To document historical human narratives within the area, promote cultural tourism in and around the park, and preserve and disseminate indigenous knowledge and cultural history.

Addo Elephant National Park (AENP) has an extensive and interesting archaeological and historical record, dating back to humans of the Early Stone Age and more recently, the area was the focus of bitter conflicts between pastoralists of European and African origin.

The services required:

- To document the oral history and human narratives with particular focus on the Sundays River Valley and marine resource users along the coastal sections of the park, through an appropriate capacity building mechanism, (to be approved by SANParks); which may include workshops with community representatives and/or stakeholders (or involve student participation).
- To capture informative narratives and anecdotes regarding community cultural and historical links with the Addo Elephant National Park.

SANParks now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.).

Only a consultant firm that is able to provide documentation/references etc. that best displays similar work and experience will be selected for the next stage of the process i.e. submission of a detailed proposal.

- Om die insiggewende vertellings en staaltjies rondom gemeenskapskulturele en historiese skakels met die Addo Olifant Nasionale Park vas te lê
