Proposed construction of the new Klein Mooimaak Rest Camp and Upgrade of the Existing Kraalbaai Day Visitors' Site at the West Coast National Park, Western Cape

Notice is hereby given of a public participation process in terms of the NEMA Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations 2010.

The South African National Parks (SANParks) propose to construct a rest camp at Kleimooimaak and to upgrade the existing Kraalbaai day visitors site within the West Coast National Park. The Kleinmooimaak rest camp will include the construction of 15 accommodation units, 20 camping and caravan sites, bulk services (water, sewer, electricity) and internal roads. The Kraalbaai day visitors' site will include the construction of an office, staff accommodation, day visitors' ablution and the upgrade of parking. The project includes a number of activities listed in terms of the amended NEMA EIA Regulations (2010) and accordingly a **Basic Assessment** is being undertaken for the following activities:

- **GN 544 of 18 June 2010 – Listing Notice 1:** 9, 10, 11, 16, 18, 22, 23, 24, 40 and 45
- **GN 546 of 18 June 2010 – Listing Notice 3:** 4, 6, 13, 16, 18 and 24
