

Kruger National Park Entrance Gates

Access for Guests with Mobility Challenges

There are nine access gates into Kruger from South Africa and 2 international border posts into Mozambique. Of the 9 entrance gates, 5 are fully accessible with pathways, ramped access into reception and unisex accessible ablutions, but the other 4 have partial access. Details are listed below.



Punda Maria Gate

| Gate | Nearest Main Camps | Accessible Ablutions | Comments |
|---------------------|------------------------------|-----------------------------|----------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| 1. Crocodile Bridge | Crocodile Bridge/Lower Sabie | Not at gate but in camp | There is a small ridge into reception. The ablutions is about 50m from reception |
| 2. Malelane | Berg-en-Dal | Yes | Large step into reception |
| 3. Numbi | Pretoriuskop | No | Reception fully accessible. |
| 4. Orpen | Orpen/Tamboti/Satara | Yes | Access good but one toilet grab rail in unsuitable position. |
| 5. Pafuri | Punda Maria | No | Remote gate with rudimentary facilities |
| 6. Paul Kruger | Skukuza | Yes | Access good |
| 7. Phabeni | Skukuza/Pretoriuskop | Yes | Access good but adjacent grab rail of toilet too far from toilet. |
| 8. Phalaborwa | Letaba/Mopani/Olifants | Yes | Access good |
| 9. Punda Maria | Punda Maria/Shingwedzi | Yes | Access good |



Orpen Gate

The accessibility at the 2 international border posts with Mozambique (at Giriyondo and Pafuri) is not known. It is reported that at Giriyondo there are ramps and accessible ablutions.
