1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this RFQ is to invite bidders to submit a quotation for **Supply, Installation and Commissioning of a Hybrid Backup Power System** for the Administration Offices in Camdeboo National Park.

3. BACKGROUND

South African National Parks (SANParks) is a public entity functioning under National Environmental Management: Protected Areas Act 57 of 2003 (Act 57 of 2003); with the mandate to conserve; protect; control; and manage national parks and other defined protected areas and their biological diversity (Biodiversity). As a public entity, SANParks is also governed by the Public Finance Management Act, Act 1 of 1999 (as amended by Act 29 of 1999), and it is listed as Schedule 3 Part A: public entities.

SANParks' operations are totally guided by its vision statement and mission statement. As a public entity, the organisation is committed to act in pursuance of transformation of South Africa's society in support of entrenching South Africa's democracy. In this regard, the organisation has adopted a transformation mission to guide its efforts accordingly.

4. SCOPE OF WORK

Supply, installation and commission **Hybrid System**, 8KW with stand battery pack to the respective dwelling/ positions in the Camdeboo National Park as is required

1. Inverter to meet requirements and equipment relevant (Mechanical and electrical)
2. Safety devices and measure equipment packs and enclosure
3. Battery pack suitable (Battery Bank Lithium Iron Phosphate Type, Free won Dryness or similar with warranties)
4. Integrations with current electrical system – essential loads for the building excluding other dwellings

4.1 Location of the Works

The Site of Works is situated within the Camdeboo National Park, Off N1, Graaffreinet, Eastern Cape.

4.2 Electrical

1. All reticulation to and from supply and equipment to be included for functionality operating the system as standby power for the house to conform to SANS 10142 and relevant regulations and by laws including Standards
2. Material and test equipment to be provided by the appointed contractor and quoted for accordingly
3. Compliance certification to be presented on commissioning as per legislation and by laws of the area installed
4. All relevant standards for electrical installing and earthing will apply to this project
5. All cable and wiring to be covered by and protected by sleeving and trunking or relevant material to make it animal proof

4.3 Mechanical

1. All relevant specifications to be adhered to regarded as priority in design and supply
2. Advice if special requirement is needed, for plinths or installation
3. Structures to conform to approved Structures

4.4 General

1. All work to conform to OHS act 85 of 1993 regulations standards and risk profiles each contractor is responsible to maintain the relevant documentation on health and safety, to be able to provide the information to the relevant Park on request
2. Material risks to be mitigated by the contractor and will be his responsibility till after commissioning, and remaining warranty period
3. The liability in terms of the products specified, supplied and installed.
 - Require that the defective equipment / faulty part to be provided and replace within the 14 days window to eliminate penalties, this

apply to product installation and product operation failure this is for the period of warranty as specified in the RFQ equipment as per supplier specified

- The installation warranty effective date commences on day of commission and Handover

4.5 Commissioning

The commissioning will be effective and acknowledged when the following is signed off on site by the authorized accredited person during satisfaction commissioning by Technical service representative

Documentation required on the day of commissioning

- Product manual
- Warranty certificate
- COC

4.6 Service level agreement

Provision has to be made for 12months to ascertain the functionality and assistance to ensure the product installed is fully functional and working conditions are adhere to

This SLA require at least two [2] visits to the site and service /advice user on outcome [in writing]

4.7 Time lines

Upon appointment the recommended supplier is expected to complete the works by within a period of two weeks (14) days, from the date of issue of purchase order, failure to complete the works within the specified timelines, SANParks reserve the right to cancel the Purchase Order.

1.5 Failure on the part of a tenderer to submit proof or documentation required in terms of this tender to claim points for specific goals with the tender, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for specific goals are not claimed.

- 1.6 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.

2. DEFINITIONS

- (a) **“tender”** means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation to provide goods or services through price quotations, competitive tendering process or any other method envisaged in legislation;
- (b) **“price”** means an amount of money tendered for goods or services, and includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (c) **“rand value”** means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
- (d) **“tender for income-generating contracts”** means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and

4. **POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS**

4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:

4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—
