## **1. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this exercise is to appoint a service provider for the **Lease of Table Mountain National Park Tokai Horse Stables for a period of 12 months, thereafter renewable on a month to month basis for 12 months.**

## **2. BACKGROUND**

South African National Parks (SANParks) is a public entity functioning under *National Environmental Management: Protected Areas Act 57 of 2003 (Act 57 of 2003)*; with the mandate to conserve; protect; control; and manage national parks and other defined protected areas and their biological diversity (Biodiversity). As a public entity, SANParks is also governed by the *Public Finance Management Act, Act 1 of 1999 (as amended by Act 29 of 1999)*, and it is listed as *Schedule 3 Part A: 25 public entities*.

SANParks' operations are guided by its vision statement and mission statement. As a public entity, the organisation is committed to act in pursuance of transformation of South Africa's society in support of entrenching South Africa's democracy. In this regard, the organisation has adopted a transformation mission to guide its efforts accordingly.

## **3. SCOPE OF WORK**

Table Mountain National Park (TMNP) is desirous to lease out the Table Mountain National Park Tokai Horse Stables.

### **The opportunity:**

To rent the stables in the Tokai Precinct area, Table Mountain National Park for a period of 12 months, thereafter renewable on a month to month basis for 12 months.

### **Equipment:**

The successful Lessee will have to bring in their equipment in order to operate and manage their livery business.

### **Refurbishment of horse stables:**

It is the lessee's responsibility to repair and pay for damage to all items occurring on the premises and/or replace all items which are broken, lost or destroyed- this is inclusive of water pipe repairs. The lessee is responsible for providing their own water if the current water supply be disrupted. This includes all relevant paddock fencing but excludes the exterior walls of the buildings as well as the roof of the main buildings. The lessee is to ensure that regular terrain maintenance including the removal of invasive alien species and general debris is conducted. A maximum of 8 horses may be kept on the premises at any given time. It is the responsibility of the lessee to ensure horses are adequately secured in stables. Six paddocks are available (as per attached map), however only five (Numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 respectively) of the six may be utilized until advised otherwise by management authority. Paddock number six (as per attached

map) is currently utilised as a site establishment area for construction contractors. Management will advise when the use of the aforementioned paddock (number 6) may be used. No additions or improvements are permitted without written consent from the management authority. No ablution facilities are available and toilet hire is required. No persons may be housed on the premises. No subletting permitted. Satisfactory public liability insurance cover required. Implementation of rodent control measures. Manure and refuse must be removed on a daily basis. Water and electricity costs will be included in the monthly rental. No signage is permitted on the premises. No pets or animals aside from horses allowed. Strictly no dogs allowed. Compliance w.r.t. SANParks' policies, rules and regulations. Non-compliance may result in punitive action.

### **Activities:**

Stabling of horses only.

### **Responsibilities:**

The Lessee will be responsible for managing their business venture and its customers as well as demonstrating commitment to adhering and complying to SANParks environmental and heritage regulations.

### **Term:**

One year and please stipulate your commencement date of this contract as SANParks would like to commence by 1 December 2022.

### **Proposal and C.V.:**

Respondents must submit a proposal that includes a monthly rental income offering to SANParks which will include escalation costs on the anniversary date and full credentials to the postal address mentioned below.

### **The interested bidder must have:**

- Extensive experience of two years in the management of stabling a minimum of two horses coupled with registration with the relevant accreditation bodies specifically in the equestrian industry. Must demonstrate knowledge of the health and safety laws and regulations as well as have the relevant Licenses.

## **4. COMPLIANCE AND GOVERNANCE VERIFICATION DOCUMENTS (Standard Bidding Documents)**

The verification during this phase is to assess the bid responses for purposes of verifying compliance with RFQ requirements, whereby a bidder may be disqualified if they do not fully comply which requirements as stipulated below:
