

GNP-025-22 RENTAL OF EARTH MOVING EQUIPMENT FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE (05) YEARS

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

QUESTION 1: Fuel- Will the machines return to a camp each night where they will be able to fill up? Or will the service provider need to include the cost for the delivery of fuel to machines left on site in their pricing?

ANSWER: Equipment might need to stay over on the road where they worked for the day. Please see Clause 2, 2.1.2 on page 20 of the tender doc

QUESTION 2: Operators- If machines are left on site, will it be the service providers responsibility to get the operators back to their machines each morning, and collect them in the afternoon?

ANSWER: Yes (same clause as above)

QUESTION 3: Operational bases- For KNP, will all operations be based in Skukuza, or will there be "satellite" bases in other regions?

ANSWER: Satellite basis in Letaba and Shingwedzi also. Road yards in the mentioned areas

QUESTION 4: I would like to find out about the logistics surrounding getting operators and fuel to their respective machines.

ANSWER: FOR KGALAGADI TRANSFRONTIER PARK –

There will be one grader with its mobile home unit, and one tractor stationed at Nossob camp. The three operators (Grader operator and assistant and tractor operator) for these machines will need transport to and from Nossob weekly. (In to Nossob from Twee Rivieren on Monday and back on Friday. The bidder can decide how their operators will work.) The transport vehicle do not need to be a 4x4 as it will only transport personnel and spares to Nossob camp from Twee Rivieren.

Graders go out on Monday and return Friday or later, depending on their hours worked. They will have fuel with them in their mobile homes as per plant specifications.

TLB – This machine will mainly work from Twee Rivieren and can get fuel at the filling station daily. When machine work outside this camp he will take additional fuel with him for that purpose.

Tractors – The tractor stationed at Nossob will work north and south of the camp and return to camp each day. Refuelling can happen at Nossob fuel station daily. An accommodation unit will need to be supplied for this operator to stay in during the week. (The successful bidder can repair an old park home at Nossob that will work fine for this purpose.) The tractor based at Twee Rivieren will mainly work in Twee Rivieren area and can refuel at Twee Rivieren fuel station daily.

Tractors will need long distance fuel tanks to be able to cover at least 250km on one filling.

There need to be a 4x4 vehicle available at Twee Rivieren to attend to the breakdowns anywhere in the park.

ANSWER: FOR KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

KNP has the filling stations within the varies camp inside the park.

QUESTION 5: Or will the service provider need to include the cost for the delivery of fuel to machines left on site in their pricing?

ANSWER: The service provider is NOT required to cost for the delivery of fuel to machine left on site in their pricing.

QUESTION 6: Operators- If machines are left on site, will it be the service providers responsibility to get the operators back to their machines each morning, and collect them in the afternoon?

ANSWER: Yes,

QUESTION 7: The Tender documents make mention off Annexure 2 – Vehicle specifications. Could you please forward Annexure 2.

ANSWER: Annexure 2 – Plant Specification is on page 25 of the same Tender document.

QUESTION 8: Please advise where we can get/procure the Mobile Accommodation unit as per the tender specification?

ANWER: You can get/procure the mobile accommodation unit from companies which are selling or in business of renting out this unit.

QUESTION 9: Please can we also humbly request for an extension of closing date due the upcoming public holidays we lose days, and we require a little more time so we can give you a well put together tender.

ANSWER: SANParks are unable to extend the closing date. The tender was advertised on the 28 March 2023 and closing 02 May 2023 @ 11H00am

QUESTION 10: Pricing Schedule – Total Rental for 5 years, does that include 12 months per year? –

ANWER: Yes

QUESTION 11: Do we have to price All items or just what we can offer?

ANSWER: Price all items

QUESTION 12: Please confirm if only 1 contract is going to be awarded or numerous?

ANSWER: Yes

QUESTION 13: Do we need to own/lease all the quantities listed in the plant list, or can we provide what plant and quantities we have?

ANSWER: You must own or proof that you can lease the plant as per bid document (Page 9 point 1 and 2 under Evaluation Phases)

QUESTION 14: Can we submit a letter of intent/commitment/OEM if we are awarded the contract the plant will be supplied?

ANSWER: Yes, you can submit hard evidence letter of intent/commitment/OEM

QUESTION 15: Can we submit award letters and reference letters for the 10 or more contracts?

ANSWER: Yes

QUESTION 16: How many contracts/ SLA or purchase orders do we need to submit for contracts value of above 10M to achieve full 40 points?

ANSWER: Please refer to page 10 for point allocation of tender document.

QUESTION 17: How many reference letters do we need to submit for 10 years or more years of experience to achieve full 40 points.
