## 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this RFQ is to appoint a suitable service provider for the **supply, installation, servicing and maintenance of the CCTV system for a period of one (1) year at Golden Gate Highlands National Park**, Clarens, Free State.

## 2. BACKGROUND

South African National Parks (SANParks) is a public entity functioning under National Environmental Management: Protected Areas Act 57 of 2003 (Act 57 of 2003); with the mandate to conserve; protect; control; and manage national parks and other defined protected areas and their biological diversity (Biodiversity). As a public entity, SANParks is also governed by the Public Finance Management Act, Act 1 of 1999 (as amended by Act 29 of 1999), and it is listed as Schedule 3 Part A: public entities.

SANParks' operations are totally guided by its vision statement and mission statement. As a public entity, the organisation is committed to act in pursuance of transformation of South Africa's society in support of entrenching South Africa's democracy. In this regard, the organisation has adopted a transformation mission to guide its efforts accordingly.

## 3. SCOPE OF WORK

The service provider will be responsible for the **supply, installation, servicing and maintenance of the CCTV system for a period of one (1) year at Golden Gate Highlands National Park**, as per or equivalent to the below description:

### A. Hotel and Chalets

- Hotel server room
- Hotel dining area
- Hotel basement area
- Hotel laundry area
- Hotel reception, parking lot area
- Hotel outside chalets (in driveways)
- Hotel hallway

### B. Glen Reenen Rest Camp

- A camera for the basement, security needed because there is a drinks and alcohol storeroom.
- Installation of Pan-Tilt-Zoom (PTZ) for Hotel Lobby Area and Park Lots should be installed.
- Cameras should be on IP since there is WI-FI networks at the Hotel.

- Outdoor WIFI access point camera for attendants

- Router -TP link ER605 Omada, Ubiquiti Edge Router X or MikroTik Hex rb750Gr3

## F. Gladstone Administration Building and Technical Department

- Cameras should allow the wireless linkage between Gladstone -Administration and Technical Building -Workshop
- Centralised NVR in the admin block
- Use Cat6a or Cat7 ethernet cables from the switch to cameras
- Use Video Management Software (VMS) for remote access
- Enable cloud back-up or offsite storage for redundancy
- VLAN segmentation for CCTV traffic
- 2 x Monitors (32 Inch-TVs) for CCTV monitoring, one monitor to be installed in the Conservation Manager Office & one in Technical Officer Office.

## G. Additional Information on Sites

- Some of the cameras are operational and are still in good working condition.
- Managers phones should be able to access activity even when he is not on site.
- Some cameras that were mounted side by side and can be changed positions for better view and coverage.
- Server should be spacious enough to allow for proper air flow, cooling and maintenance.
- Run a single-mode fibre optic link between the Gladstone Admin Building and Technical Department Storeroom Areas
- Use media converters or fibre switches to connect fibre to standard Ethernet at both ends
- Place Poe Switch at the storeroom to power cameras
- Centralized NVR in the Administration Building
- Use Cat6a or Cat7 ethernet cables from the switch to cameras
- Use Video Management Software (VMS) for remote access
- Enable cloud back-up or offsite storage for redundancy
- VLAN segmentation for CCTV traffic
- Gladstone Admin block and Storeroom should go with fibre optic cable due to the distance between the two areas and UPS should be used for the power back up.
- A connection will be needed for Gladstone Administration Building to Technical Department Storeroom as the Wi-Fi is limited at Gladstone Administration Building and the distance is between 4550-500m separating the two points.
- Use Fibber for distance of 250-300m and A router with VPN support for remote monitoring between Gladstone Administration Building and Technical Department.

- To appoint the service provider for **supply, installation, servicing and maintenance of the CCTV system for a period of one (1) year at Golden Gate Highlands National Park.**
- Cameras should cover up to 30m range.

- Dome IP Cameras (HiLook by Hikvision Vari Focul 4MP IP Dome camera, 40M night vision, 2.8-12mm)

- Regular maintenance and software updates of CCTV Hotel & Chalets, Filling Stations, Shop, Glen Reenen Reception Area, Gladstone Administration and Technical Services for Golden Gate Highlands National Park.
- Customer service agreement should be in place for regular maintenance and software updates of software for period of 12x Months.
- Cramping of cable (under 100m)
- Online support for period for 12x months
- Repair and configuration of current system will be to get the system online.
- Faulty cameras should be replaced, repair where necessary should be done.
- Storage should be enough on local hard drive and iCloud-based service.
