1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this RFQ is to invite a supplier to submit formal written quotation for the repair of Thatch roofs at Renosterkop, Restcamp and replace the Nutex roof at Lagoon house.

2. BACKGROUND

South African National Parks (SANParks) is a public entity functioning under National Environmental Management: Protected Areas Act 57 of 2003 (Act 57 of 2003); with the mandate to conserve; protect; control; and manage national parks and other defined protected areas and their biological diversity (Biodiversity). As a public entity, SANParks is also governed by the Public Finance Management Act, Act 1 of 1999 (as amended by Act 29 of 1999), and it is listed as Schedule 3 Part A: public entities.

SANParks' operations are totally guided by its vision statement and mission statement. As a public entity, the organisation is committed to act in pursuance of transformation of South Africa's society in //support of entrenching South Africa's democracy. In this regard, the organisation has adopted a transformation mission to guide its efforts accordingly.

3. SCOPE OF WORK:

It is not compulsory for contractors to do site visits, for accurate measurements on these work as stipulated below an appointment can be made with the technical officer to.

SANParks needs to appoint a company to Repair:

1. Cottage one Renosterkop 112.9 m²

Thatch must be pulled back and rotten pieces cut off and removed. Short bundles of Cape thatch must be filled in. Old Cement flashing must be removed and replace with new. Capping must be removed and replaced with new.

2. Renosterkop Entrance Gate

Concrete strip for gate rail must be cast. Wall must me plastered on the inside. Stone cladding must be done on the outside off the wall.

3. Restcamp Main building 357.25 m²

Thatch must be pulled back and rotten pieces cut off and removed. Short bundles of Cape thatch must be filled in. Old Cement flashing must be

removed and replace with new. Capping must be removed and replaced with new.

4. Lagoon house;236.98 m²

Removal of old nutex roof plates and replace with 48Colorbound AZ200 Corrugated AFR Charcoal W30/M 36/4.650m and 18/3.860m Roof Plates. Extra purlins to be added between existing purlins with extra braziers to be added.

5. Paint work to be done on all the capping:

- Cottage 1 @ Renosterkop
- Gate Entrance @ Renosterkop - Matching existing Bosheuwel Gates
- Main Building @ Rest Camp – Matching existing buildings charcoal color
- Lagoon House - Matching existing building color

Payment will be made in accordance with the PFMA (within 30 days of receipt of invoice) after the service has been rendered.

9. FINAL AWARD

SANParks recommends the bidder who has quoted on all the items as required in terms of the RFQ for the contract award, subject to the bidder having supplied the relevant administrative documentation and complied in all aspects with the terms and conditions and requirements of the RFQ.

- 1.6 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.

- (a) “**tender**” means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation to provide goods or services through price quotations, competitive tendering process or any other method envisaged in legislation;
- (b) “**price**” means an amount of money tendered for goods or services, and includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (c) “**rand value**” means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
- (d) “**tender for income-generating contracts**” means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
